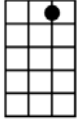

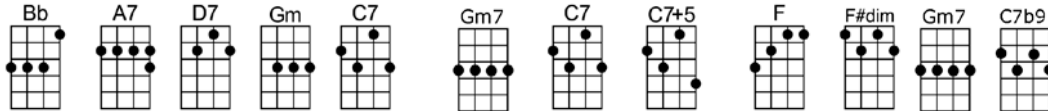

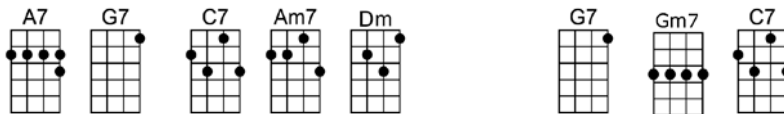
Place: park, scene: dark, silvery moon is shining through the trees;



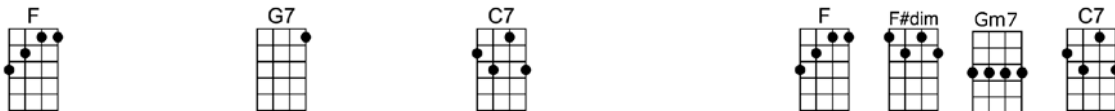

Act one, be - gun. Dialogue: "Where would you like to spoon?"



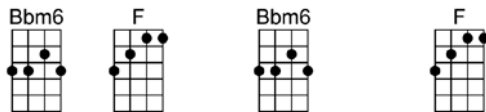
