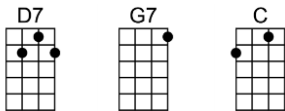
Five foot two, eyes of blue, but, oh, what those five feet could do!

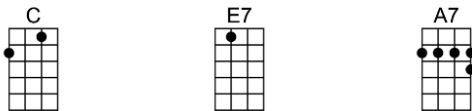


Now if you run into a five foot two covered with fur,
